1. Please describe and give introduction about yourself and your internship project in KMUTNB.

My name is Jordi ESCUYER. I am 23 and I am an engineering student at EIVP (Ecole des Ingénieurs de la Ville de Paris) in Paris (France) in which I'm studying urban and civil engineering.

At EIVP, I am studying issues linked to the urban environment, whether it deals with town and country planning, purification of water or pollution, but I have also some studies of the environment and sustainable development. I have successfully completed my first year of studies in urban and civil engineering. Also, before my entrance in this school I studied for 2 years thermal and energies sciences. Then I had to do one year of preparatory classes specializing in scientific subjects, where I learnt a lot about physics, mathematics and chemistry.

My internship in KMUTNB deals with Geopolymer properties. I have to learn more about this material and then, make a study about thermal and mechanical properties of different form and mix of geopolymer.
